

MISSOURI RIVER VALLEY CONFERENCE

The MRVC was originally formed as the BIG FIVE Conference in 1928. The schools represented in the original BIG FIVE were: Cameron, Carrollton, Excelsior Springs, Liberty, and Richmond. Lexington and Marshall were added making the BIG SEVEN. Higginsville took the place of Cameron in 1937, and Slater was added in 1941, leading to the formation of a committee to rename the conference. This is when the MRVC was founded. Listed are all of the schools that have entered or left the conference.

- Charter member of the Big Five Conference
- Did not compete in basketball from 1931-32 through 1935-36 seasons due to lack of a gym

Excelsior Springs Tigers:

- Charter Member of the Big Five Conference
- Did not compete in football in 1942 due to World War II
- Withdrew from MRVC competition following the 1970-71 school year
- Entered the MRVC West for the 2008-2009 School year

Grain Valley Eagles

- Enter the MRVC for the 2004-2005 school year

Higginsville Huskers:

- Entered the Big Seven Conference for the 1937-38 school year
- Known as the Higginsville Bluejays until 1950

Harrisonville Wildcats:

- Entered the MRVC West for the 2008-2009 School year

Holden Eagles:

- Entered the MRVC East for the 2008-2009 School year

Kearney Bulldogs:

- Entered the MRVC in the 1980-81 school year
